## HOW TO TRANSPORT CHILDREN

This page provides an overview of the regulations relating to the transport of children in different types of vehicles. This overview is based on articles 35 and 44 of the road traffic regulations. These provisions apply to children under 135 cm. Children over 135 cm and adults under 135 cm are not subject to it.

CRS = child restraint system

Vehicle type	Age of child: < 3 y	? 3 y & < 8 y & < 135 cm	? 8 y & < 18 y & < 135 cm
Personal transportation device	unauthorized, unless the device is constructed for that purpose		
Bicycle, cycle	doesn't have to be in CRS, can also be in trailer		
Two-wheeled moped	unauthorized	in CRS	doesn't have to be in CRS
Motorbike ?125 cm <sup>3</sup>	unauthorized	in CRS	doesn't have to be in CRS
Motorbike >125 cm <sup>3</sup>	unauthorized	unauthorized, unless in sidecar with CRS	doesn't have to be in CRS
Car, van	in CRS and only on seats equipped with seat belt	in CRS and in the front only if seat belt is present	in CRS and in the front only if seat belt is present
Taxi	must not be in CRS but without CRS, not in the front and if there is a CRS it must be used		
Bus	doesn't have to be in CRS		
Other motor vehicle	in CRS	in CRS or with seat belt	in CRS or with seat belt

Comments:

- This table does not take into account the exceptions in article 35.1.2.  
A rear-facing CRS can only be fitted on seats without a front airbag or when the front airbag is deactivated.  
Only trailers attached to cycles or motorized cycles can transport passengers. A trailer cannot carry more than two passengers and must be equipped with seats that provide effective protection for the hands, feet and back.
